STATEMENT ON THE MURDER OF REVEREND JEAN JACQUES OLA BÉBÉ, RADIO HOST

How far will the downward spiral of our country, Cameroon, go?

On Friday, 3 February 2023, amid the national and international indignation and revolt caused by the heinous murder of MARTINEZ ZOGO, we learnt with horror of the murder the day before of another man of the media, also a religious man, Reverend Jean Jacques OLA BÉBÉ. On my own behalf and on behalf of the Cameroon Renaissance Movement (CRM), I send my deepest condolences to his biological family and to the media family.

The unfortunate victim, also known for his denunciations of the shortcomings of the various clans of the regime fighting at the top of the State, had mentioned the murder of MARTINEZ ZOGO on a media outlet a few days earlier. This other murder, which occurs while the judicial authorities are still keeping an overwhelming silence on the sponsors and killers of MARTINEZ ZOGO, is a genuine challenge to the Republic by mafia-type clans. Indeed, the very survival of the State of Cameroon is now threatened by these gangs who publicly clash for the control of public resources and the materialisation of their disastrous political project of anti-democratic monopolisation of State power.

This situation is the direct consequence of the flagrant failure of the current regime which, not content with impoverishing Cameroonians and making the country regress, is contributing to the fragmentation of the Nation.

The CRM demands, as it did in the case of the barbaric and odious execution of MARTINEZ ZOGO, that all light be shed on the murder of Reverend Jean Jacques OLA BÉBÉ, and that the masterminds and perpetrators of this other heinous crime be actively sought, arrested, brought to justice, and severely punished.

Cameroon, our country, is on the verge of chaos, and it continues to be managed by means of communiqués, often contradicting each other. Is there still a Commander on board? If there is one, it is time that he put an end to this dangerous drift for the country, that the power of the

State so much praised in other circumstances does not only manifest itself when it comes to spilling blood in the NOSO or to exercise blind repression against the peaceful and innocent militants of the CRM, who denounced what everyone, including the sitting President of the Republic, is denouncing today.

He must take the country back from the mafia gangs that are terrorising the citizens unless he himself accepts to be one of their targets.
