

STATEMENT ON THE DEADLY ACCIDENT ON THE BERTOUA - NGAOUNDERE ROAD

I have learnt with great sadness of the death of about ten passengers following a serious traffic accident – yet another one – on the Bertoua - NGAOUNDERE road on Tuesday, 9 May 2023.

I would like to send my condolences as well as those of the Cameroon Renaissance Movement (CRM) to the families of the victims. To the many injured, both serious and minor, I wish them a speedy recovery.

While waiting for the light to be shed on the real circumstances of this new tragedy on our roads, the Government is mistaken in systematically passing the buck to drivers and travel agencies. They certainly have their share of responsibilities, but the state of our roads is one of the major explanatory factors of the numerous accidents that plunge Cameroonian families into mourning. The country is reduced to counting the des ans dream of a developed and modern railway network and motorways with international standards and speed control norms that are known and effectively implemented.
