PRESS RELEASE ON THE 65th ANNIVERSARY OF THE ASSASSINATION OF RUBEN UM NYOBE, NATIONAL HERO

On 13 September 1958, Ruben UM NYOBE, the Secretary General of the Union of the Populations of Cameroon (UPC) was assassinated in Boumyebel by foreign forces and their Cameroonian and African auxiliaries, because of his love for his country, Cameroon.

65 years after this assassination following which our country gained independence although disoriented, the Mpodol fight remains relevant despite all the betrayals - and they were and are still many.

Indeed, the question of the strategic emancipation of Cameroon and the improvement of the standard of living of our compatriots put forward by UM NYOBE and his comrades remains unresolved.
