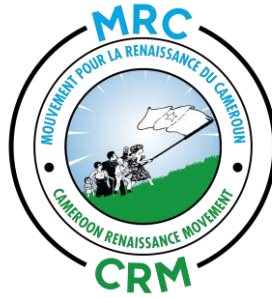

STATEMENT ON THE REPEATED STAIN OF THE IMAGE OF CAMEROON BY THE REGIME IN PLACE.

The CPDM regime does not ruin Cameroon only because of the endemic corruption and the massive embezzlement of public funds; It does not stop in oppressing the little guys, poor and affected by obnoxious taxes and duties, hit hard by the regular increase of the price of basic goods without an increase of their purchasing power; It has decided to continue the bad job in an area where, in good times and bad, we managed to save face: that of sport. After the burlesque show that this regime has been offering the world for several months in football between the Government and Fecafoot, the no less laughable exclusion of the women's national handball team from the qualifying tournament for the Paris Olympics for failing to comply with the documentation required to obtain visas, now the divagation in the organisation of the African Athletics Championships. All foreign participants uttered very harsh words expressing deep anger at the chaos in the organisation of this event which could have been an opportunity to expose our country to sports fans around the world. The regime could have limited this incompetence, this carelessness and this lack in imagination that stain the image of Cameroon, and allow the athletes and their supporters to enjoy the diversified and excellent Cameroonian cuisine even in the urban misery of a country where citizens have taken, without appointment, the Ministry of Talking in Africa. No! It should be noted that the CPDM regime is completing the job started before leaving. As if that was not already so humiliating for our country and the Cameroonians that we are, it presents the other side of its ugly face to visitors, by banning through sub-divisional officers, not only the public meeting of a political opposition party, the CRM, to avoid the risk of a "mega-meeting", but also the handing-over to the people in the far north of the country of a water borehole that it failed to provide to them after being called several times for help. Reason: "risk of serious public disorder"! Should we laugh or cry? The CPDM regime has not only tarnished the image of Cameroon but torn the national flag. Those who are talking in the name of that party daily should leave us alone and stop blaming those who, in

their opinion, stain the image of Cameroon. Because Cameroon has no image now since they have decided to ruin the country.

With the failed organisation of the African Athletics Championships taking place in Douala, criticized unanimously by participants in this continental event, how would the regime exploit the gigantic sports facilities built at exorbitant costs if they so much discourage international sports organisations which could use them?
